

**PROVINCIAL GRAND CHAPTER MEETING**  
**INVESTITURE PROCEDURE**  
**MARCH 2023**

1. Companions are required to wear a dark suit or morning dress, an East Lancashire Festival or Provincial tie, [the RA or Craft tie or a black tie is acceptable; other ties are not acceptable], Royal Arch clothing. **Please note that gloves should not be worn.**
2. Please enter King George's Hall, using the Northgate [side] Entrance and register your attendance. After registering please make your way upstairs to the main Hall where you will be required to register your attendance as a Companion receiving Promotion or Appointment and obtain your reserved seat number.

**Please Note:**

- If you have difficulty in walking and / or ascending stairs, please enter King George's Hall, via the Blakey Moor [main] entrance, where assistance will be given.

***There is no disabled access via the Northgate [side] entrance – please use the Blakey Moor entrance where assistance will be given.***

- An additional cloakroom is provided for those Companions who will be dining after the Meeting. This is located in the Windsor Suite, which can be accessed via the main entrance [Blakey Moor]. Stewards will be on duty to direct Companions where necessary.

**Appointment to Acting / Past Rank**

3. On entering Provincial Grand Chapter, if you are to be **appointed to Acting Rank, or are receiving your first Appointment to a Past Rank**, you should wear your Apron and Sash, but **carry** the Collar with which you will be Invested. **You should proceed to the East part of the Chapter Room, report to the registration Steward at the table situated on the left hand side of the centre of the stage and a numbered seat card will be handed to you.** You will then be directed to your reserved seat, which will be in the West, under the centre balcony.
4. If you are receiving an Acting rank your Collar Jewel will be handed to you by the Registration Steward. This Jewel should be worn at all times during your year of Office and should be returned **irrespective of any Ceremony**, on or before **28 February 2023. You will then need to purchase and to wear a Past Jewel.**

**Promotion to Past Rank**

5. On entering Provincial Grand Chapter, if you are to receive a **Promotion to a Past Rank** you should wear the **Apron, Sash, Collar and Jewel** of your new rank. You should proceed to the East part of the Chapter Room, report to the registration Steward at the table on the left hand side of the centre of the stage and a numbered seat card will be handed to you. You will then be directed to your reserved seat.

6. **YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO ASCEND THE SIDE STEPS TO THE LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE STAGE TO RECEIVE YOUR HONOUR. IF DISABLED, OR HAVE DIFFICULTY IN EITHER ASCENDING OR DESCENDING STEPS, YOU SHOULD CONTACT THE HELP DESK, [01706 833170] AT THE PROVINCIAL OFFICE, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.**
  
7. I would remind you of the traditional etiquette / courtesy, if you are unable to attend the Meeting, an email or letter of apology should be sent to the ME Grand Superintendent [Email: [secretariat@eastlancsmasons.org.uk](mailto:secretariat@eastlancsmasons.org.uk) or send a letter to c/o Mrs Susan O'Neill, Rossendale Masonic Hall, Ashday Lea, Haslingden Road, Rawtenstall, BB4 6QX], at the earliest opportunity. You will, subject to your acceptance, be able to use your new rank **after** the meeting of Provincial Grand Chapter.
